Entrance to the country park



You can drive or walk into the country park.

If you are walking you should be careful of cars
because there isn't a footpath.

Blue badge spaces in the car park



There are four spaces for blue badge holders. The spaces are a bit wider than most car park spaces.

Pay for your parking



There are two machines to pay for your parking. One is near the entrance and one is near to the gate by the building called the 'Old Goods Shed'.

The parking machines takes coins, contactless cards and you can also pay using the RingGo app.

The RingGo app code number is 4467.

Car Parking Prices



The parking charges are listed on the sign.

You must pay for parking everyday between 9am and 7pm.

All visitors, including Blue Badge holders, are asked to pay. This helps us keep the park open and looking after it for everyone.

The photograph of this sign was taken on 6th June 2025. The charges might have changed since then.

The Goods' Shed



The Old Goods' Shed is one of the two buildings in the country park. It is used for exhibitions, meetings and even wedding receptions.

It is not usually open for the public.

The Goods' Shed



At the back of the Goods' Shed is one of the toilets.

The Goods' Shed – accessible toilet



At the back of the Goods' Shed is a toilet that is DDA compliant.

Other toilets are available at the other end of the country park near to the children's play area.

This toilet is open from 9am until 5pm in the summer. In winter it is closed when it goes dark, usually about 4pm.

Inside the Goods' Shed toilet



This toilet is DDA compliant and can be used by anyone.

The toilet is cleaned at various times during the day.

Clare Railway Station



This is the old Clare Railway Station.

This building has a café inside.

Inside the 'Platform One' cafe



This is the inside of the café. It can feel a little bit cramped if you don't like people to be too close to you.

You can get food and drinks to take-away from the window on the platform side of the café.
